- Bring a list of all medications you are currently taking, including prescription and non-prescription (or bring the medications themselves).
- Bring a copy of previous allergy testing records.
- Withhold antihistamines 48 hours prior to your appointment (72 hours for Zyrtec). You may continue to take your asthma inhalers, nasal sprays and any other prescription medications.
- Please do not wear any perfume or other fragrances to your appointment.
- Children under age 18 must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian for the entire appointment.
- Parking is free.

We will submit insurance claims on your behalf. Please bring your insurance card along to your visit. If your health plan requires a referral from your primary care physician in order to receive care at our office, please make sure the referral has been requested prior to your appointment with us.
